# ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY

*Momentum Group provides the industrial and construction sectors in the Nordic region with consumables and components as well as related services.*

## 1 Introduction

Environmental efforts within Momentum Group are performed as an integrated part of the business operations. The purpose of this policy is to describe Momentum Group's approach to its work on environmental issues and the Group's impact on the environment.

## 2 Environmental Policy

Momentum Group's "Environmental Policy" expresses the Group's desire to accept its share of responsibility for showing respect for the environment and contributing to lasting sustainable development.

Environmental efforts are to be conducted within the framework of the Group's business concept and be well integrated into operational activities. The Group aims for a holistic approach to environmental issues by means of high employee competencies and constantly developing the Group's knowledge of environmental effects. When choosing suppliers, products and services, the Group strives for minimum environmental impact insofar as this is technically feasible, economically viable and environmentally justified. An eco-cycle approach and economic use of resources are to be key points for the Group's business operations. We aim to contribute to reducing resource and energy consumption by focusing on efficient transport solutions and high-quality products and services.

By meeting or exceeding the requirements stipulated in environmental laws and statutes, Momentum Group aims to stimulate every part of the commercial chain to prevent and reduce adverse environmental impact by making continuous improvements.

## 3 Organisation and distribution of responsibility

Each individual company in the Group is responsible for daily environmental efforts, which are to be performed according to the specific conditions and needs of each company.
